First opening in 1986 with pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten, the school graduated its first senior class in 1994 and is now one of the largest Christian schools in the area with approximately 620 students. Our mission is "To train students to think, live, and lead as Christians based upon a Biblical worldview." For this reason, our teachers are committed to challenging students intellectually, spiritually, and practically so they are prepared to understand, express, and live their faith.
