NEW STUDENT APPLICATION PROCESS 2009-2010 SCHOOL YEAR

Admissions Criteria: The student and at least one parent with whom the student resides must be a professing Christian and regularly fellowship in a local church. The student must have at least a C average and be in good standing at his/her previous school.

Admission Procedure: Submit completed application and forms to the school office. (Children must be 4 years old by September 30th to enter Pre-K or 5 by September 30th to enter Kindergarten.) Upon receipt of your application, it will be reviewed. If an entrance test or developmental readiness test (depending upon the student's age), is needed, you will be contacted with available appointment times. The final step to enrollment is the student/family admissions interview with the school administrator. You will be contacted by mail of the status of your application.

School Hours: Pre-K: 8:05 a.m. – 2:40 p.m.
Kindergarten – 5th grade: 8:05 a.m. – 2:40 p.m.
Jr./Sr. High – 8:05 a.m. – 2:50 p.m.

Registration and Resource Fees: A non-refundable new student registration fee of \$250.00 per child must be submitted with the completed application. (Not to exceed \$500 per family) The resource fee of \$325.00 per will be added to your tuition payments. Once you have had your family interview, you will be asked to enroll in FACTS (manages tuition payments) and this will serve as your commitment and secure your child's slot.

Tuition: See the tuition rates on the website. The first payment begins June 5th or 20th, 2009. (depends on your draft selection) Discounts are given for siblings.

Discipline: The school uses a warning/natural consequence/detention system for correcting behavioral problems. Repeat offenders will be sent to the principal and if necessary, parents will be contacted.

Extended Day Care: There is Before and After School Care (BAC) available from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for students enrolled in K-5th grades. Students in 6th-8th grades must be enrolled in after school study hall if they cannot be picked up by 3:00 p.m. or they are not involved in an after school sport. See the attached sheet for rates and information.
