



## **NEW STUDENT APPLICATION PROCESS 2008 – 2009 SCHOOL YEAR**

**Admission Procedure:** Submit completed application and forms to the school office. (Children must be 4 years old by October 15<sup>th</sup> to enter Pre-K or 5 by October 15<sup>th</sup> to enter Kindergarten.) Upon receipt of your application, it will be reviewed. You will be contacted for a student/family admissions interview with the school administrator. The last step is an entrance test or developmental readiness test depending upon the student's age. You will be contacted by mail of the status of your application.

**School Hours:** Pre-K: 8:05 a.m. – 2:40 p.m.  
Kindergarten – 5<sup>th</sup> grade: 8:05 a.m. – 2:40 p.m.  
Jr./Sr. High – 8:05 a.m. – 2:50 p.m.

**Registration and Resource Fees:** A non-refundable new student registration fee of \$200.00 per child must be submitted with the completed application. (Not to exceed \$400 per family) The resource fee of \$325.00 per child is due immediately after acceptance and serves as a non-refundable commitment fee to secure your child's slot.

**Tuition:** See the tuition rates on the website. The first payment begins July 1, 2008. Discounts are given for siblings.

**Discipline:** The school uses a warning/natural consequence/detention system for correcting behavioral problems. Repeat offenders will be sent to the principal and if necessary, parents will be contacted.

**Spiritual Life:** Bible study and prayer are encouraged in each class. Students are encouraged to seek the Lord's will in every situation in their lives.

**Extended Day Care:** There is Before and After School Care (BAC) available from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for students enrolled in K-5<sup>th</sup> grades. Students in 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grades must be enrolled in after school study hall if they cannot be picked up by 3:00 p.m. or they are not involved in an after school sport.
