1 package 3x5 index cards (stays in classroom)

**Spanish** (not needed if taking Writing Workshop)

3 whiteboard markers (stays in classroom)
Earbuds for Chromebook use
College ruled loose leaf notebook paper (stays with student & may need to be replenished throughout the year)
Index Cards (approximately 200 to start, stays in classroom)
Spanish to English Dictionary (optional, some available in the classroom)

**Art** (only needed if selected as elective)
