Financial Policies

- Registration/Re-Enrollment Fees are due at the time of the application submission.
- All families are required to enroll into FACTS Tuition Management and are responsible for fees assessed by FACTS.
- Students will not be enrolled into classes until all Registration/Re-Enrollment Fees have been paid.
- Tuition payments cannot fall more than 31 days in arrears. Students will not be able to attend overnight class trips or be allowed back into class until the account has been brought current.
- Any reenrollment received after March 15 will be considered a late reenrollment and are subject to an additional \$50.00 per student Late Returning Student Fee.
- Capital Fee covers the acquisition, upgrade, and improvement of facilities. This includes expenses like painting, carpeting repairs, classroom repairs, playground maintenance, landscaping, etc.
- Students are considered enrolled for the entire school year; therefore, budget and teacher contracts are set accordingly. The early withdrawal of a student creates an opening which FCS may not be able to fill. A fee of \$500 will be charged to students who withdraw after their financial agreement has been submitted, *with the exception of military orders*.
- Leaving a Legacy Giving- This annual fund provides resources for our school, outside of the operating budget, that directly impact our mission of Christian education excellence.
