

Children under 18 traveling without either parent--

1. Unabridged Birth Certificate
2. Affidavits from the parents or legal guardians listed on the birth certificate confirming that the child may travel with that person
3. Copies of the ID documents or passports of the parents or legal guardian
4. Contact details of the parents or legal guardian
5. Death certificate if parent listed on birth certificate is deceased
6. Court order/custody order if parent listed on birth certificate is not present in child's life

To summarize: valid passports, an unabridged birth certificate and parental consent affidavits are required for each child when one parent or another person is travelling with somebody else's child. Minors travelling in school groups or with their grandparents are not exempt from the requirement.

We urge you to take steps to obtain Unabridged Birth Certificates, and any other documentation required, such as a Parental Consent Affidavit, as soon as possible to avoid delays to your trip
