

## Senior Year Checklist

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. Submit all college applications before October 1st.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. Review your transcript to make sure that it is accurate then fill out a transcript request form for each college to which you have applied, and take them to the Guidance Office.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. Complete scholarship applications.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. Request your FSA ID Number. (See your chart with deadlines for information on how to do this).
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. Fill out the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) ASAP starting October 1st.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. Keep in contact with Admissions at colleges to which you have applied to check on the status of your applications and to check for any missing items.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. Keep in contact with Financial Aid at colleges to which you have applied to check on grants and scholarships.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 8. Let the counselor know any decisions sent to you by colleges; whether acceptance, rejection, or waiting list and any scholarship decisions.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 9. Confirm and reject acceptances to colleges.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 10. Send in required deposits before the deadline.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 11. Register with the military after your 18th birthday—boys only.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 12. Meet all deadlines.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 13. Register to vote after your 18th birthday.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 14. Walk with God and pray for wisdom and discernment to make wise choices for now and for the future.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 15. Fill out a final transcript request for the college you plan to attend (by May 1<sup>st</sup>). These can be found in the Guidance Counselor's office or on the FCS website under quick links.
