Items not included in tuition are those fees applied to the whole family (Campus Improvement Fee, Campus Police and Fundraising) and fees based on individual choices such as bus fees, fine arts attire, high school class trips, uniforms, lunch, before and after school programs, etc.

BRIDGE (Pre-K – 5 th)	An alternative learning environment for non-traditional learners.	\$3,800
CONNECTIONS SUPPORT (6 th -12 th)	Curriculum support for students who need additional help with coursework. (2 days a week)	\$2,100
CONNECTIONS SUPPORT PLUS (6 th -12 th)	Curriculum support for students who need additional help with coursework. (3 days a week)	\$3,000
CONNECTIONS INTENSIVE (6 th -12 th)	Alternative curriculum at skill level, and/or daily curriculum support for classwork. Design modifications and accommodations as needed. (5 days a week)	\$3,800
STEM CLUB (2 nd -5 th)	Students will experience full immersion of cross curricular skills. First come, first served. (1 day a week)	\$500

*Support/Enrichment Programs require a commitment for the entire school year. No sibling discounts can be given to students enrolled in these programs. These fees are not covered by the NC Opportunity Scholarship.

FINANCIAL POLICIES

- Registration/Re-Enrollment Fees are due at the time of the application submission.
- Students will not be enrolled into classes until all Registration/Re-Enrollment Fees have been paid.
- All families are required to enroll into FACTS Tuition Management and are responsible for fees assessed by FACTS.
- Tuition payments cannot fall more than 31 days in arrears. Students will not be able to attend overnight class trips or be allowed back into class until the account has been brought current.

WITHDRAWAL POLICIES

Once your Financial Agreement has been submitted, you are reserving a slot for your child. Student(s) who withdraw after their Financial Agreement has been submitted will be assessed a \$500 withdrawal fee per child, unless withdrawal is due to military orders or requested by the Administration. All transcripts/records will be held until accounts are paid.
