Sick Policy & COVID Exposure Policy

Updated Sick Policy

Effective Fall, 2021 until further notice

<u>Symptoms</u>	<u>Required Action</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ONLY Fever 100.4 or higher OR • ONLY Nasal congestion and/or runny nose OR • ONLY Sore throat OR • ONLY vomiting 	Return to School (RTS) 24 hrs after fever-free or symptom-free without use of medication OR doctor note clearing to return to school
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fever 100.4 or higher AND any of the following: • New cough (or change in baseline ie allergies) • Difficulty breathing (or change in baseline) • New loss of taste or smell 	a. If no COVID test, or positive COVID test: stay home 10 days b. If COVID test negative: RTS 24 hr after fever-free without use of medication, and other symptoms are resolving

Exposure Policy

Exposure is defined as being within 6 ft of positive COVID case (3 ft in school setting) for at least 15 minutes

<u>Symptoms</u>	<u>Required Action</u>
Students who have been exposed but have no symptoms	a. Stay home 10 days unless vaccinated b. Vaccinated (or positive COVID case within last 3 months): may RTS
<p><i>Per updated Cumberland County Health Dept guideline:</i> If the exposure took place at school, students who are wearing a mask on the day(s) of exposure are not required to quarantine.</p>
