# Fayetteville Christian School Sick Policy & COVID Exposure Policy

### **Updated Sick Policy**

#### Effective Fall, 2021 until further notice

Symptoms	<b>Required Action</b>
<ul> <li>ONLY Fever 100.4 or higher OR</li> <li>ONLY Nasal congestion and/or runny nose OR</li> <li>ONLY Sore throat OR</li> <li>ONLY vomiting</li> </ul>	Return to School (RTS) 24 hrs after fever- free or symptom-free without use of medication <b>OR</b> doctor note clearing to return to school
<ul> <li>Fever 100.4 or higher AND any of the following:</li> <li>New cough (or change in baseline ie allergies)</li> <li>Difficulty breathing (or change in baseline)</li> <li>New loss of taste or smell</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>a. If no COVID test, or positive COVID test: stay home 10 days</li> <li>b. If COVID test negative: RTS 24 hr after fever-free without use of medication, and other symptoms are resolving</li> </ul>

## **Exposure Policy**

Exposure is defined as being within 6 ft of positive COVID case (3 ft in school setting) for at least 15 minutes

<u>Symptoms</u>	<b>Required Action</b>
Students who have been exposed but have no symptoms	<ul><li>a. Stay home 10 days unless vaccinated</li><li>b. Vaccinated (or positive COVID case within last 3 months): may RTS</li></ul>

#### Per updated Cumberland County Health Dept guideline:

If the exposure took place at school, students who are wearing a mask on the day(s) of exposure are not required to quarantine.
