Sick Policy

Effective Fall, 2022

<u>Symptoms</u> Students with any of these symptoms	<u>Required Action</u> must do this
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fever 100.4 or higher• Vomiting• Diarrhea	Return to School (RTS) after at least 24 hrs being fever-free or symptom-free without use of medication OR the date a doctor note says when to return to school
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Symptoms of pink-eye	Return to School (RTS) with a doctor note (usually can be same day after treatment starts)

Additional notes about illness

- Students that become sick at school must be picked up within 30 minutes of notification.
- If a doctor note is provided to the school for an appointment or for a period of illness, the absence code for the affected days will be changed from "A" to "AN" to show that a medical note was provided. But **ALL ABSENCES, REGARDLESS OF CODE**, count toward the maximum allowable absences for the school year (20 days).
